Also, I received a letter from a former resident that had to move because her absentee landlord and property manager did absolutely nothing to correct numerous violations. She had written documentation that these issues would be fixed however the property manager did nothing.

This former resident and tenant did everything right; however, the absentee landlord and local property manager chose to do nothing. The house has been relisted. How many good neighbors do we have to lose before someone in city government starts doing their job? This is not the first time that my wife and I have heard this story. This world is full of scam artists. Please tell anyone that you know that is thinking of leasing a house in our neighborhood to document everything in writing and get a written promise that the landlord will fix these issues. If they do not comply, please contact the appropriate department in the City of Detroit.

RENTAL PROPERTY INFORMATION

LANDLORDS: Provide an awareness of Grandmont Community's high standards and zoning regulations. We are an (R1/R2) Residential Zoned neighborhood. There are certain zoning limitations that need to be observed. For instance, commercial vehicles are not allowed on our properties overnight. Certain occupations cannot be legally operated out of homes without an authorized zoning variance. Please alert prospective tenants of expected community-minded actions and behaviors. Informational packets are available that detail City Ordinances and Clean Neighborhood Initiatives. We will gladly provide these to new residents.

Responsible Property Investors obey City of Detroit regulations and register their properties. In some cases investors will pay Association dues or share that expense with the resident. Good investors appreciate the fact that organized neighborhoods create safer surroundings and improved quality of life services for the entire community while adding value to their own investments. Home repairs are made in a timely manner. We are grateful for their efforts and support.

The weak spots of some Property Investors can include non-compliance with Lead Abatement. High level lead in paint has been proven to endanger young children. Often, properties are rented or leased with only cosmetic improvements being made. In some cases, taxes are not being paid on these properties. These taxes provide the City Services we depend upon for our healthier quality of life.

The **GRANDMONT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION**, along with our four other neighborhoods in the **GRANDMONT ROSEDALE COMMUNITIES**, working through the **VACANT PROPERTY TASK FORCE**, are committed to improving the safety and security of all residents, homeowners and leaseholders.

DID YOU KNOW? ALL rental properties need to be **registered** with the City. A Certificate of Compliance is required annually for all rental dwellings in the City – regardless of whether vacant or occupied. Call **BSEED (Buildings, Safety Engineering & Environmental Department)** if you believe a rental property is not in compliance at **313-628-2451**.

OUR MISSION STATEMENT NOTES THAT THE GRANDMONT COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD. WE ARE ALL SHAREHOLDERS OF OUR FUTURE.

RENTERS: Please respect the property, avoid overcrowding, and keep your home and yard neat and clean. Light the night; park in your garage or driveway and off the street if possible. We welcome and encourage your involvement in the Grandmont Community. Grandmont supports good neighborhood habits, not bad ones. These are the expectations we hold for all residents, property owners and tenants.

GRANDMONT PATROL #4 ~ 1st AWARDS CELEBRATION



Grandmont Patrol #4 was organized almost 50 years ago in the mid-1960's. Grandmont residents have always stepped up to look out for each other and help keep our Grandmont community safe. There have been many changes over the years with members coming and going, moving away or passing on but we've stayed the course and now have one of the oldest, largest and best-organized radio patrols in Detroit. Our members volunteer almost daily to watch out for each other, report and secure vacant houses, report blight, work with animal control and report suspicious activity, people and vehicles.



GRANDMONT PATROL #4 ~ OFFICERS & STAFF

On Saturday, November 19, 2016, our first awards celebration was held at Christ the King Church. Over 40 patrol members were honored for their volunteer service. Everyone had a great time socializing and eating the good food provided by CJ's Catering.

Julie Janusch was recognized for going **"ABOVE & BEYOND"** volunteered for **240 HOURS**; the most number of hours of all patrollers in the past year! Patrol Secretary James Liddell was given the Grandmont Patrol #4 **SUPERHERO**

Award. He volunteered for **162 HOURS** and drove an astounding **958 MILES** – all in Grandmont!!

Overall, Grandmont Patrol #4 members volunteered on behalf of our community for **2568 HOURS (486 HOURS were driving) AND DROVE 4419 MILES in the past year** – all in Grandmont!! Crime is much lower in Grandmont than in surrounding communities without an active patrol. You may not see us, but we are out on the road ~ protecting our residents and helping to keep "Grandmont – the Home of Good Neighbors!"
