SEPTEMBER, 2017 PRESIDENT'S REPORT ~ MARK JANUSCH

I have not written an article for the Grandmonitor since June. A lot has happened since then, so let me bring the association up to date.

We just finished a very successful Art Fair. Jomo King and his volunteers have once again worked hard to put on our signature event that showcases our community. This year we had more interested sponsors than we had space available at Ramsay Park. Profits were in excess of **\$1,400** which will go into the Grandmont Scholarship fund. It was a HUGE success; Thank you Jomo and volunteers!

We have a new website: <http://grandmontcommunity.org> – please check it out. It has a completely different look. One of the new features is a tab to link sponsors who advertise in the Grandmonitor to their web page or Facebook page. Our former web designer Jennifer Leonard decided to step down in July and Grandmont neighbor Mark McCrae volunteered to take on the responsibility of web designer and web coordinator replacing board member Charlotte Wright. The GCA Board has contracted his services in this capacity. This will insure a smooth and continuous operation of our website and keeps the option of PayPal for dues payment functioning. Thank you Mark and also thanks to Jennifer and Charlotte for their service!

Also, I am sorry to report that dues collection is behind last year's totals. To date we have only collected dues from 193 households out of a total approximately 1100 homes and apartments in the community. To those that have already paid for 2017, thank you for your continued support and faith in the Grandmont Community Association!

Without adequate participation, it will be difficult to sponsor street snow plowing. Snow plowing is our single greatest expense. It cost **\$4,300** to pay for this service last year. It is not fair that 20% of dues paying households pay for the whole neighborhood. Please make it a point to write your check today and mail it to our P.O. Box 27790 Detroit, MI 48227; see membership application on page 3. You may also use PayPal as an option. And you may also pay your Block Captain. The choice is simple, either pay your association dues so that we continue with this service or purchase a set of snow tires. North Rosedale Park went without street snow plowing last year. So please pay your dues if you want this service to continue!

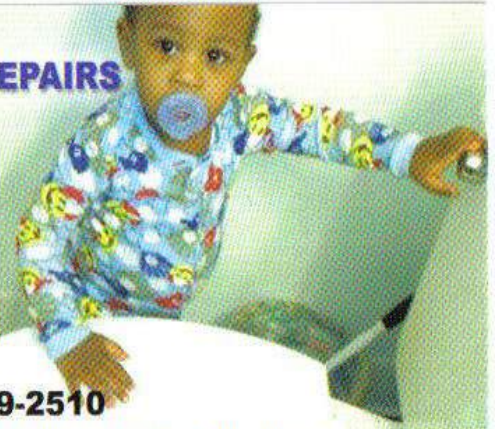
