# Presidents Report January 2018

Happy New Year to all Grandmont Residents.

As I write my report in mid December, we just got 4 inches of snow, it was nice to wake up and see the beautiful blanket of fresh snow and that our **streets had been plowed**. Vincent Ford, owner of All Seasons Landscaping, gave me a courtesy call this morning to see if everything was ok and if we had any concerns. Great service I said! This is part of what your \$25 annual dues go for along with many other services that we provide as a community association. Your board went out on the limb to pay for this service even though dues lag behind last year with only 250 paid households. So please pay your dues for 2018, snow plowing costs the association \$4300 for the season and we need a lot more residents paying association dues to cover this service. It is not fair that only one resident out of 4 pays, while 3 get a free ride. Enough said, enjoy the safe plowed streets this winter and **pay your association dues and thank you to those who have already paid**.

That was a very nice service, however much like our own GCA dues collection, Clay decided that it was not worth his time and effort when only 3 or 4 residents on each block were paying for his service and the other neighbors got a free ride.

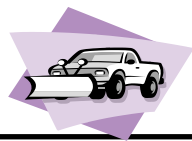
# VACANT PROPERTY TASK FORCE / ENVIRONMENTAL CORNER

Without Action, You Aren't Going anywhere.

“Don't Make a New Year's Resolution, **be a Part of a New Year's Solution!**”

In other words, be more active in your community. Be part of the solution ... where more hands means less work for everyone.



**REMINDER:** Yard Waste Pick-up of Branches & Leaves by the City (Advanced Disposal) is **OVER for the season.** Yard Waste Pick-up for 2018 will begin in late April or early May. Bulk Pick-up continues every other Monday. Please pay attention to the schedule (tickets are expensive and should be unnecessary!) Put your Bulk Items at the Curb the Sunday evening before the scheduled Monday morning pick-up. Your neighbors appreciate your consideration.

**REMINDER:** When it's Snowing in Grandmont....**MOVE CARS, COURVILLES & RECYCLING CARTS OFF THE STREETS!** Please DO NOT PARK your vehicle on the Street, especially when snow is in the forecast! You take the risk of having your car plowed-in. You won't be happy... and your neighbors won't be happy to have snow piled in the street. **Please be a considerate neighbor. Working together, we will all enjoy a smooth winter season.**

## FYI—Property Tax Help !

Our Vacant Property Task Force continues to advocate for more homeowners and less investors in Grandmont. The “Neighbor-to-Neighbor” Tax Foreclosure Prevention Outreach Program is a way to be pro-active now if you are behind in your property taxes. Please contact UCHC/United Community Housing Coalition. **Walk in Hours are 9am-12pm Mon, Wed, and Fri. Located at 2727 Second Avenue, Suite 313, Detroit 48202.** This FREE service offers highly knowledgeable, confidential help and information. They offer assistance to homeowners as well as renters and can help determine if tax relief is available based on your circumstances. The location is served by DDOT Bus Routes 16-Dexter, 53-Woodward, 21-Grand River, 23-Hamilton, and 31- Mack. There is also free, nearby street parking. Please call me, or the Wayne County Treasurer (313-224-5590) if you need help in determining if you owe property taxes. You need to verify that ALL years' taxes are paid.

### Remember two things:

1. you are not alone, and
2. there is help available

**Environmentally Speaking**, while Nike's Logo of “*Just Do It*” is a big part of how things get done in a neighborhood, there is a good argument for it's polar opposite, “*Just Don't Do It*”... *Don't* speed down our streets, *Don't* put your garbage container out too early or bring it back too late, *Don't* park on the lawn, and *Don't* litter. *Don't* walk your dog without a leash and scooper, *Don't* let your children play in the street, and *Don't* disrespect your neighborhood. Your Neighborhood is where you and your family live and should always be a safe haven and clean community for everyone in Grandmont.

## HPTAP

AKA: The Poverty Tax Exemption

The Homeowner's Property Tax Assistance Program (HPTAP) lowers City of Detroit property taxes for low-income homeowners. If you have a bridge card or qualify for other government programs for low-income households, you are likely eligible! This program does not help with back taxes to Wayne County Treasurer, but by stopping this year's taxes from piling on, it may make owed taxes easier to pay off. You can still apply before December to have your 2017 taxes lowered.

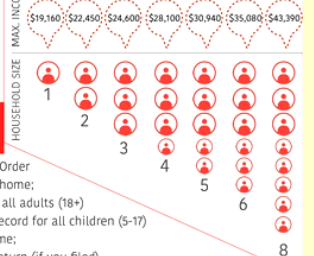
