**REMEMBER:** Friday is our new pick-up day in Grandmont!

Garbage is picked up EVERY FRIDAY. "Everything" - bulk, recycling, and yard waste - is pick ups EVERY OTHER FRIDAY.

**Pick-up dates:**  
September 7th (Sat -due to Labor Day Holiday)  
September 20th  
October 4th, Oct 18th  
November 1st , Nov 15th,  
and Nov 30th (Sat due to Thanksgiving Holiday)

**A Helpful Reminder:**  
**FIRST:** Add this number to your phone contacts: 313-800-7905.  
**THEN** text your address (example: 12345 Grandmont) to that number. You will be notified as to **WHAT** will be picked up and **WHEN** by 6pm the night before the appropriate pick-up date. It's that simple.

**SAFETY & SECURITY REMINDER:** It's getting darker earlier. Please light the Night. Turn On Your Porch Lights! If you can't see something, you can't say something if a crime is occurring. And unfortunately, there are people looking for an opportunity to do damage. Don't make it easy for them. Plan to attend our Neighborhood Safety Meeting at North Rosedale Park Community House at 6:30 on Thur. 9-26-19.

Reminder: You only have until September 15th to fill out the Senior Citizen Application for Solid Waste Discount. The application period is July 1 thru September 15th. The City of Detroit may provide a discount to homeowners who are at least 65 years old and have a household gross income below \$40,000. Effective July 1, 2009, the Solid Waste Fee is \$240.00 (listed on your tax bill) Qualifying Seniors will receive a discount of \$120.00.

# FALL ORGANIZATION

## checklist

The change of the seasons means it's time to start preparing your home for winter! Use this checklist to prep for cooler temperatures

### PORCH & DECK

- Empty and stow planters for the winter
- Sweep the porch and deck
- Give any outdoor rugs a wash and store for the winter
- Wash the windows
- Clean the grill and store it (if necessary)
- Clean and stow patio furniture and pillows

### GARAGE

- Declutter tools and equipment
- Sweep the floor
- Get rid of lingering trash and clutter
- Bring out snow shovel and sleds
- Store warm weather tools
- Bring out rakes

### CAR/VAN

- Change out car emergency kits for colder weather
- Check tires and fluid levels

### FRONT & BACKYARD

- Remove hoses from outdoor spigots
- Clean and store fire pit (we like to do this toward the end of fall)
- Cut down dead trees or hanging limbs
- Clean up yard
- Close pool

### HOUSE (INTERIOR)

- Clear debris from downspout
- Replace bulbs if needed in outdoor lighting
- Clean out gutters
- Check vents
- Prepare firewood
- Inspect roof and exterior of home

### HOUSE (EXTERIOR)

- Check weatherstripping and replace if needed
- Wash screens and storm doors
- Service the furnace
- Sweep the chimney
- Check furnace filter
- Check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Set thermostat for winter months

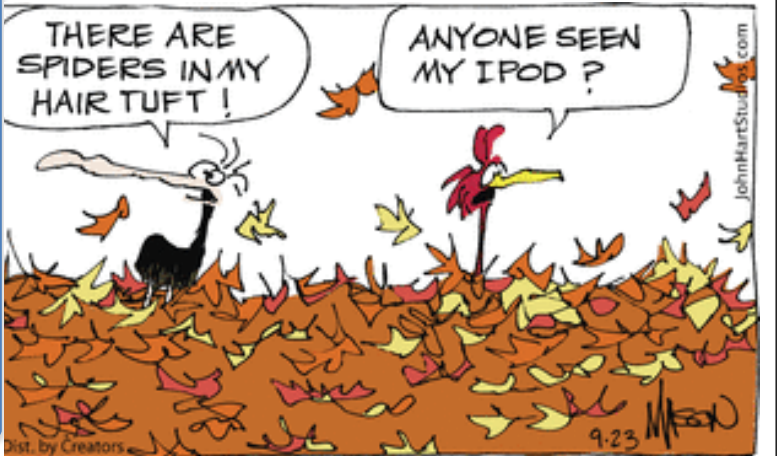
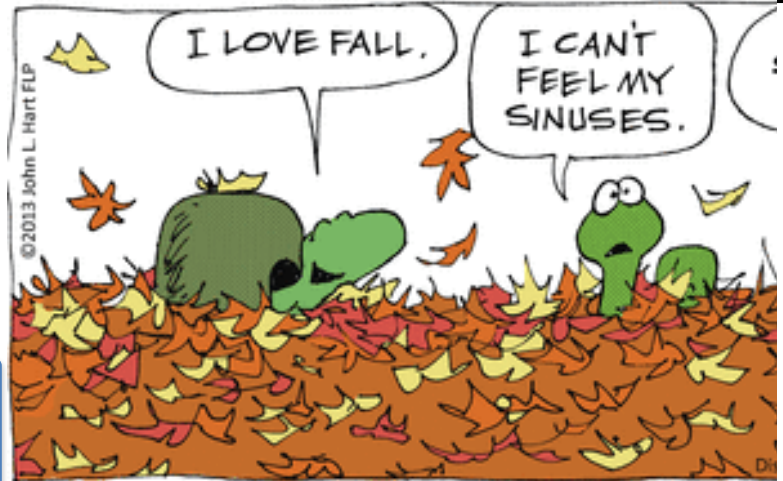

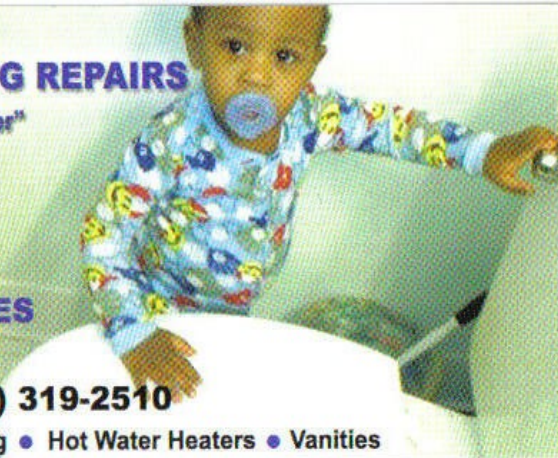
