- A. ARTS & CRAFTS FAIR (Jomo King): no report
- B. BEAUTIFICATION (Larissa Richardson): Motor City Makeover May 1 (30 volunteers) at Ramsey Park to clean up and plant flowers. A really successful event! Upcoming events Flower day of action in the neighborhood in the planters and Chaney Library. In July planning a cooperative event with the Garden Bug business. Beautification meeting is Tuesday, June 8 at 6pm via zoom!
- C. ENVIRONMENTAL/VACANT PROPERTY TASK FORCE (Harrison Duke III & Diane Patterson):
 - 1. Purchase Offer Pending sale for the GRDC Renovated house on Archdale.
 - DLBA (Detroit Land Bank Authority) working on renovation of another house on Archdale near Schoolcraft.
 - 3. Beautification Grant through VPTF & TCF Bank Possible use to purchase 2 Vacant Lots at Woodmont & Archdale, both near Gr.River for future neighborhood signage/ beautification. Lot cutting and flowers, supply purchases will also be a considered use of the grant. (Possibly could purchase the land with grant funds. Aaron Hall said that there's someone who he knows that wants to purchase it but they haven't been able to.)
 - 4. Woodmont Vacant Lot cutting by the Land Bank is not on schedule. Last year we paid to have a portion of the fence removed to allow for commercial cutters to mow per LB request. This year there are still concerns with their cutting schedule. Resolution should be next week.
 - 5. Email sent 5-27-21 to D1 Inspector Veasy regarding 5 houses of concern in Grandmont. 2 are vacant and not being maintained by the owners. Inspector Veasy visited all 5 properties and issued violations. Owners will have time to comply, but tickets will be issued if corrections are not made.
 - 6. Possible Squatter on Asbury Park being investigated. Used Improve Detroit to report this concern.
 - 7. The owner of a vacant house in the 14400 block of Abington was contacted about a possible Nuisance Abatement Posting by the City. He is trying to sell the house if he can, rather than continue to rent it as he is not in compliance with the City rental ordinance and isn't taking care of the backyard.
 - 8. As of now, we are grateful that volunteers are cutting the lots on Southfield Service Drive.
- D. GRANDMONITOR (Sandi Miller): Has a new position at work so really needs articles to come in on deadline because time is limited. Please communicate with Sandi if you will be late. The
